# **Mid-Year Financial Snapshot**

Summer is upon us with hopes of life sustaining rainfall on everyone's minds. I thought it would be appropriate to give a mid-year update on Westminster's finances as our Church, through God's words, sustains our bodies and souls.



Through the first 6 months of 2023, our revenue stood at \$302,360 slightly below last year's \$305,881 and just shy of this year's budget by \$4,528 or 49% of budget. The primary source of Church revenue is from pledges and offerings which totaled \$284,239. Year-to-date we are running a \$25,671 surplus of revenue over expense.

Expenses have been running a bit lower than budgeted as we have outlays totaling \$276,688 which is approximately 45% of budget. Expenses so far this year are slightly more than last year's \$271,331. When we look at budget comparisons, we are running slightly higher in property expenses but we have had several non-reoccurring, but needed, maintenance costs for this first half of the year. The largest expense is in our personnel areas with this trending slightly below budget, however we anticipate this to trend upward as Rev. Craig was officially welcomed in July as our Head Pastor.

As we enter the second half of the year, please think about satisfying your \$41 Per Capita. If you have not thought about using e-giving please do so by contacting Becky Dietz for more information. Thank you for all your gifts to Westminster.

# Feed My Starving Children

Westminster will host their 15th packing event on <u>October 16 - 18, 2023!</u> Registration will begin in September. We received some exciting information about FMSC and wanted to share it with you.

In June, FMSC volunteers packed the *4 billionth MannaPack meal* since their founding in 1987. This milestone was reached at a MobilePack event hosted by inmates and staff of the women's prison at the Minnesota Correctional Facility in Shakopee, MN.

- 31,273,704 meals were shipped in June
- 31 Food Partners and 29 countries were served
- **5 top** countries receiving FMSC meals in June:
- 1. **Haiti** 5,243,328 meals
- 2. **Guatemala** 3,418,272 meals
- 3. **Honduras** 3,225,600 meals
- 4. **Nicaragua** 2,551,392 meals
- 5. **El Salvador** 1,931,040 meals

**FMSC Fun Fact**: Food for the Poor was FMSC's largest food distribution partner in June receiving 18 shipments - which equals **5,042,304 ManaPack Meals**!
